Implementation of Income Support Grant (Phase II)

The Ministry of Social Development and Family Services (MSDFS), wishes to advise of the following Income Support Grant for vulnerable persons given the recently introduced COVID-19 prevention measures. To qualify for this assistance, persons must have lost their income **on or after May 1st, 2021** in accordance with Public Health Regulations (Legal Notices #124 and 131).

INCOME SUPPORT GRANT

The Income Support Grant is up to a maximum of \$1,500 for the month of **May 2021 ONLY**. Once eligible, persons who lost their income with effect from May 1, 2021 will receive \$1,500. Persons who lost their income with effect from May 8, 2021 will receive \$1,000.

IMPORTANT NOTE!

- **Only persons who do not have a NIS number should apply.**
- **Only persons who lost their income on or after May 1st, 2021 should apply.**
- **All false and misleading information contained in the application will be reported to the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service for their investigation and further action.**

To apply, please visit the Ministry's website at **www.social.gov.tt** and click on COVID-19 Social Support. **Only online applications will be accommodated.** The deadline date for applications is **June 11, 2021.**
