How do we get HIV?

By exchanging infected body fluids such as:

- Blood
- Semen
- Breast Milk
- Vaginal Secretion

Testing for HIV

You have the right to get tested and be respected.


- ✓ An HIV Test checks to see if you have the virus in your body.
- ✓ Most tests are done quickly.



What is HIV/AIDS?

HIV is a virus that attacks your body's defenses.

AIDS is the position where your body can't defend itself.
